

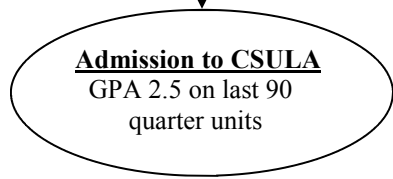

**Steps 1 & 2: Admission**

**Application Deadlines**

Fall            June 15  
 Winter        October 1

**Step 3: Conditionally Admitted**

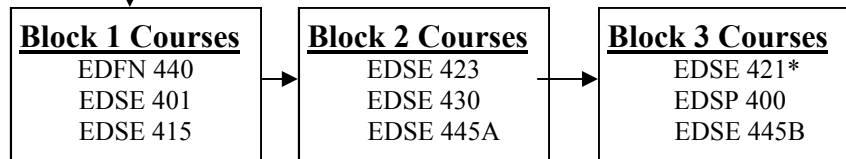
Complete Prerequisite Courses/ Requirements

- WPE

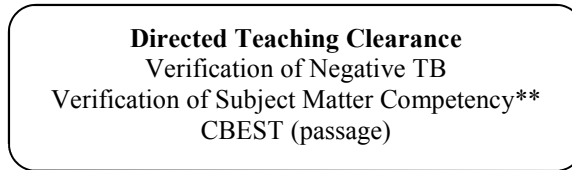
**Step 4: Formal Admission**

Enroll in Restricted Courses  
 Blocks must be completed in sequence



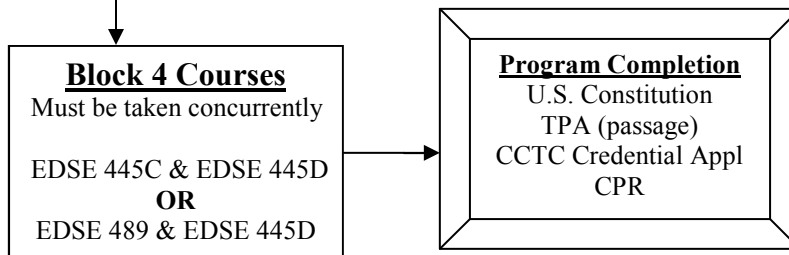
**Step 5: Supervised Practicum**

Attendance at the Mandatory Directed Teaching Meeting (at least one quarter prior—1st Saturday of each quarter; 8:00-10:00 am)



**Step 6: Program Completion**

Apply for Credential by the 5th week of the quarter.
